This Old Assyrian Bibliography will be supplement to and therefore follows the structure and the table of contents of OAAS 1 [C. Michel, *Old Assyrian Bibliography of Cuneiform Texts, Bullae, Seals and the Results of the Excavations at Aššur, Kültepe/Kaniš, Acemhöyük, Alişar and Boğazköy*, Leiden, 2003]. The Bibliography of this volume contains corrections and additions to OAAS 1: books and articles published since February 2003 till the end of July 2006, titles published before and forgotten in OAAS 1, reviews, new tablets discovered during the excavations or housed in private collections, line quotations of tablets preserved in the Museum of Anatolian Civilizations in Ankara, etc. My thanks go to the editors of *Archiv für Orientforschung* who give me the opportunity to publish regular updates of the *Old Assyrian Bibliography* and I also wish to express my gratitude to all colleagues (already mentioned in OAAS 1, pl. VII) who helped me with this supplement, especially İ. Albayrak, J. G. Dercksen, C. Günbattı, A. Karaduman, C. I. Karasu, G. Kryszat, F. Kulakoğlu, M. T. Larsen, N. Özgüç, S. Ö. Savaş and K. R. Veenhof.
