

APPENDIX

SYNOPSIS OF HITTITE CULT-INVENTORY TEXTS

As noted on p. 1, the Hittite cult-inventory texts follow no one pattern. They present data in differing sequences; paragraphs divide the texts in varying ways; and there are differences in what, if anything, is described in the texts. The following outline presents a summary of the materials found on pp. 2-8 above. An asterisk indicates that the text so marked is presented in full transliteration and translation in chapter iii.

- I. Texts arranged or grouped according to sequence of data presentation (pp. 1-5).
 - A. Cult center--deities (this order can be reversed) --images and symbolic objects--offering materials --festivals. KBo II 1* (with exceptions, see above, pp. 2 f), 7*, 8, 13*, KUB XII 36 and duplicate XXX 37, XVII 37, XX 14, XXV 23*, VBoT 26.
 - B. Deviations from this sequence. The deviations are quite numerous, and each applies to an extremely limited number of texts. To list them here would be to duplicate pp. 1-5, q.v.
- II. Use of paragraph dividing lines (pp. 5 f).
 - A. Preliminary paragraph--(line)--festival descriptions --(line)--concluding paragraph--(line)--major divisions of text (see above, p. 5) separated by double line. IBoT I 9, II 103, KBo II 7*, 8 (double line used erratically here), 13*, KUB VII 24 obv.*, XII 36 and duplicate XXX 37, XIII 32 obv., XVII 35*, 36, 37, XX 14, XXV 23*, 24, 25, VBoT 26, 49, 122.
 - B. Deity's all but complete inventory contained between one set of lines; one deity's inventory follows that of another. IBoT II 106, 108.

- C. Similar to preceding, except that cult center is noted in a separate, lined-off paragraph that may either precede or follow the series of deities and their inventories. VII 24 rev.*, XII 2*.
- D. All inventories of deities worshiped in a given town, as well as mention of that town, contained in one lined-off section of a text. IBoT II 104, KBo II 1*, 16, KUB XII 3.
- E. Miscellaneous. See above, p. 6.

III. Descriptions in cult-inventory texts (pp. 6-8).

- A. Texts containing no descriptions. HT 14(?), IBoT II 106(?). On these two texts, see above, pp. 6 f.
- B. Texts containing descriptions of material objects only. IBoT II 105, 108(?), KBo II 1*, 16, von Brandenstein, HG, texts 1, 2, 3, 4.
- C. Texts containing descriptions of festival activities, but not of material objects. IBoT II 103, KBo II 7*.
- D. Texts containing descriptions of material objects and festival activities. KBo II 8, 13*, KUB VII 24*, XII 2*, 36 (and duplicate XXX 37), XVII 35*, XXV 23*, VBoT 26.

IV. Miscellaneous, unclassifiable fragments. See above, p. 15, note 4.
