

Vorwort.

Das vorliegende Heft XV der Keilschrifturkunden aus Boghazköi hat Herr Joachim Schiele zum Verfasser. Lediglich in der Beschaffung des Materials, dem Nachweis zugehöriger Texte, habe ich ihn unterstützt. Der Plan des Ganzen und die Ausführung im einzelnen gehen allein auf ihn zurück. Die Reinschriften der ersten Blätter sind bereits im November 1924 entstanden. Schwere Krankheit hat mehrfache Unterbrechung der Arbeit notwendig gemacht, was leichte Unebenheiten in der Anordnung der Texte zur Folge gehabt hat, und schwerstes Leiden hindert Herrn Schiele auch jetzt, diese einleitenden Bemerkungen, die er ausführlicher zu halten beabsichtigte, selber zu geben. Ich beschränke mich unter teilweiser Verwendung seiner vorläufigen Aufzeichnungen auf das Notwendigste.

Die vorliegenden Texte scheiden sich in drei Gruppen.

I. (Nrr. 1—30). Weihinschriften. Die Stücke enthalten — zumeist in direkter Rede (1. ps. sg.) — Versprechungen von Weihgaben an eine Gottheit unter der Voraussetzung, daß sie den Wünschen des Redenden Gehör gibt. Eigentümlich ist der Mehrzahl der Texte die Formel (*kis-an*) IK-RU-UB. — Die Nrr. 16 und 17 sind Duplikate.

II. a) (Nrr. 31 und 32). Ein umfangreiches Ritual über das KAS^{pl}-az *huitliḡanar* bestimmter Gottheiten. Die beiden Texte sind Duplikate.*)

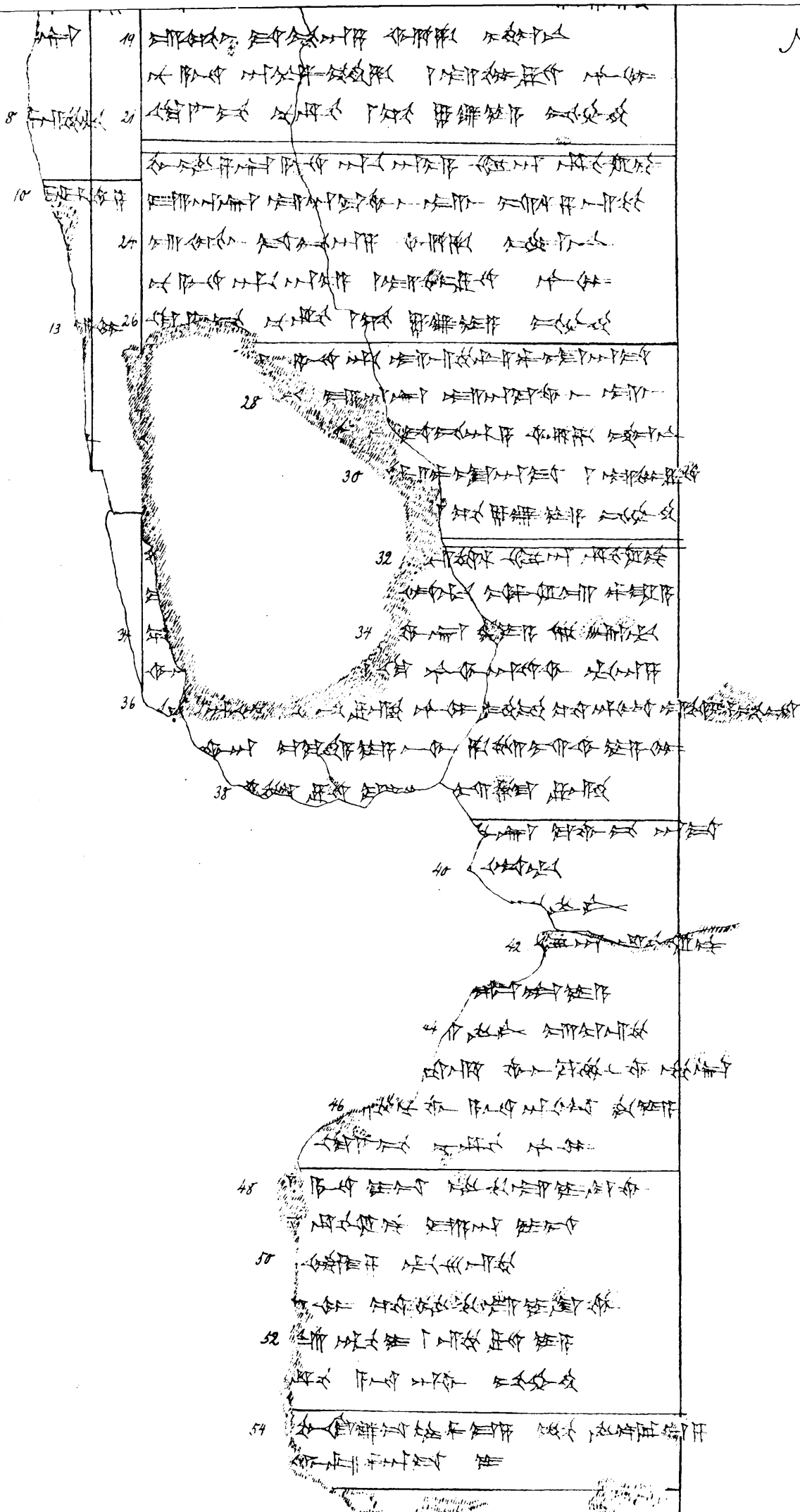

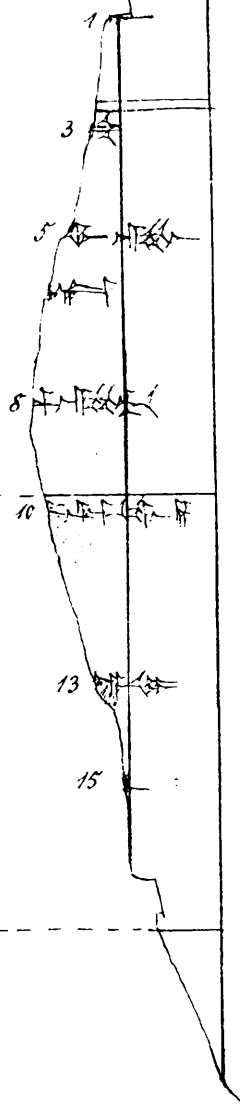

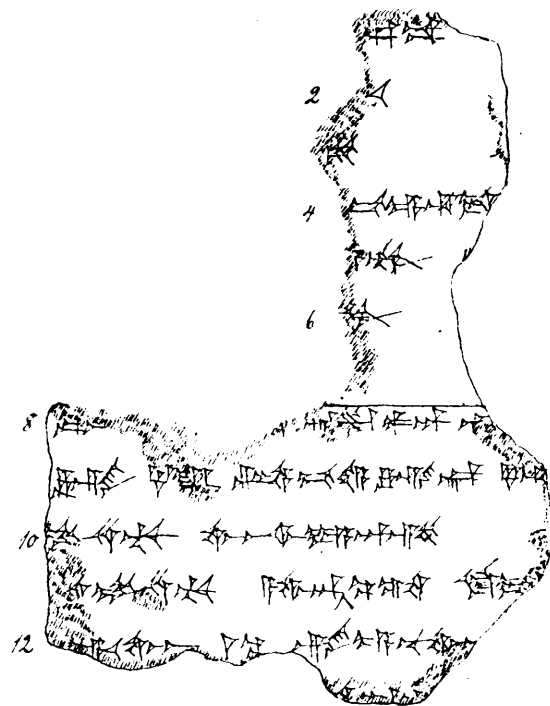

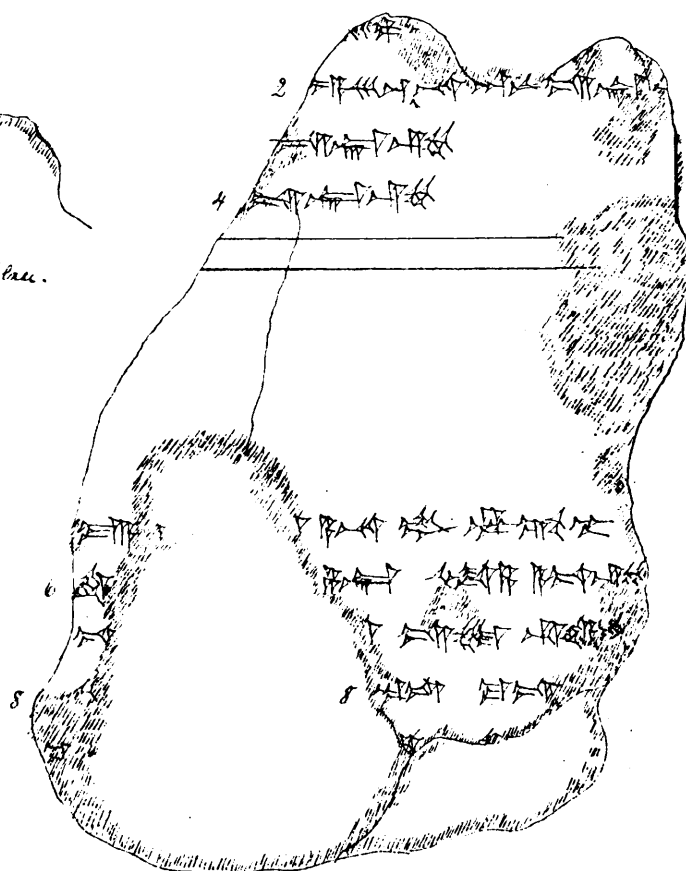


Nr. 2. Bo 3401 Vs.

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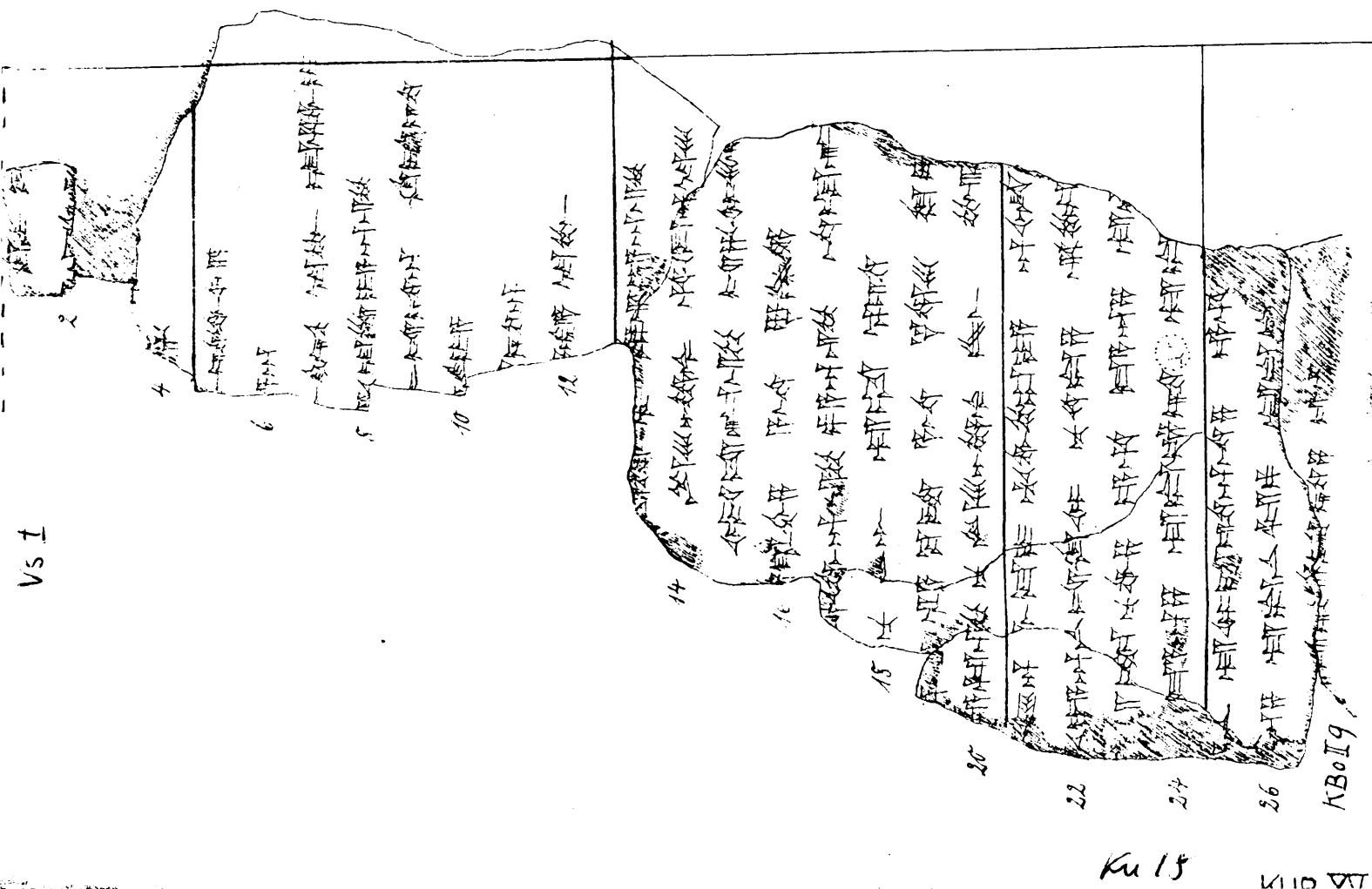
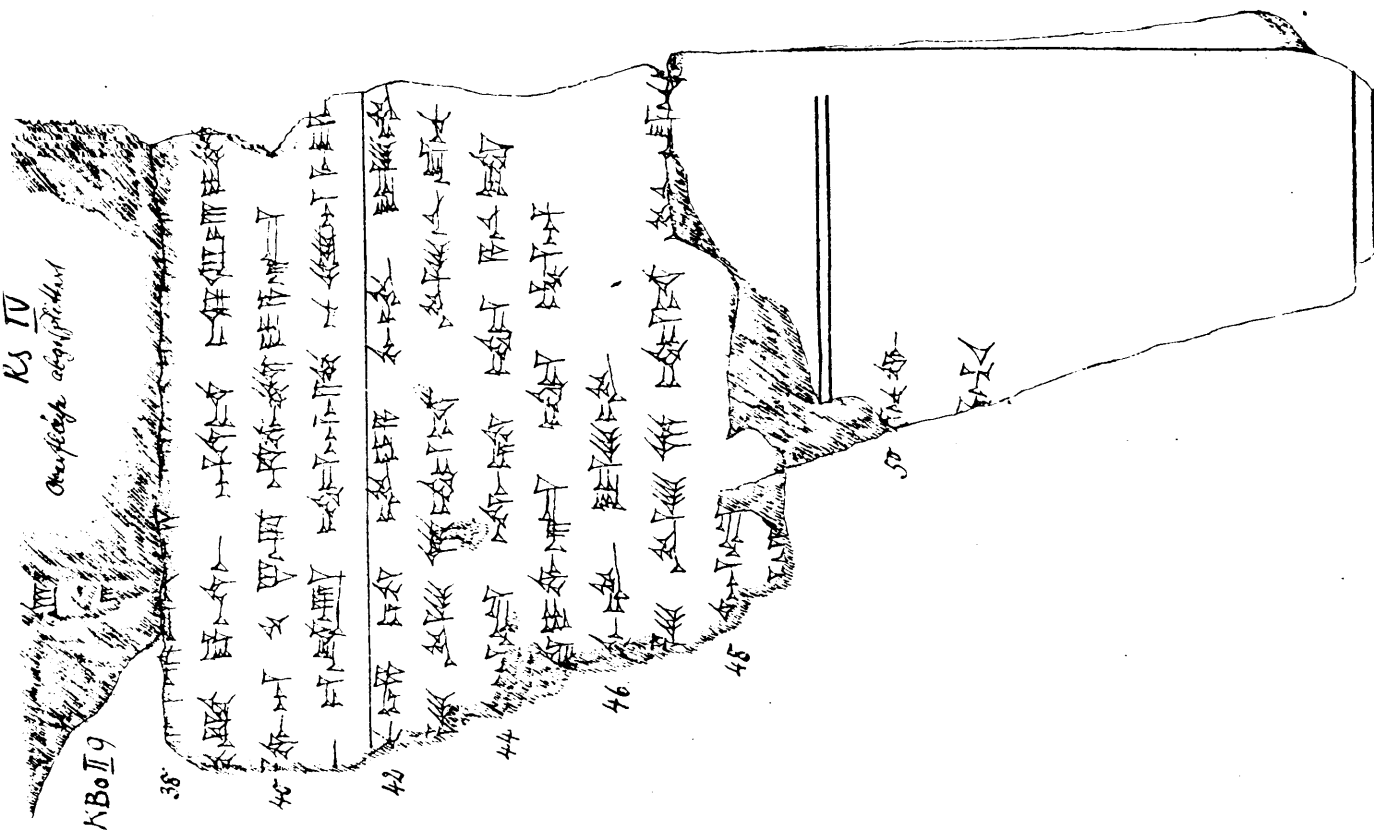
