In diesem Heft werden Texte aus Boğazköy vorgelegt, die sich bis zum Herbst 1987 im Vorderasiatischen Museum in Berlin befanden. Die Kopien konnten noch fertiggestellt und kollationiert werden, bevor alle in Berlin aufbewahrten Bo-Nummern an die türkischen Eigentümer zurückgegeben worden sind. Aufgenommen wurden Tafelfragmente, die bei dem nummernweisen Vorgehen bisher nicht berücksichtigt wurden und deren Bo-Nummern zwischen Bo 1000 und Bo 2600 liegen; das Heft schließt damit an KUB LVII an. Ausgelassen wurden auch hier nur einige wenige Bruchstücke, die sehr stark abgerieben sind und eine Kopie nicht erlaubten.

Damit sind praktisch alle Bo-Nummern bis Bo 2600 ediert, die während des ersten Weltkrieges seitens der türkischen Behörden zur Konservierung und Bearbeitung nach Berlin gegeben worden waren. Ein beträchtlicher Teil der übrigen Bo-Nummern ist bereits ebenfalls in den „Keilschrifturkunden aus Boghazköi“ sowie in KBo und IBoT entsprechend ihrer sachlichen Zusammengehörigkeit als Kopien publiziert worden. Es ist zu hoffen, daß der noch verbleibende unveröffentlichte Teil der Texte aus den Grabungen Hugo Wincklers der Forschung gleichfalls bald zugänglich gemacht werden kann.
