

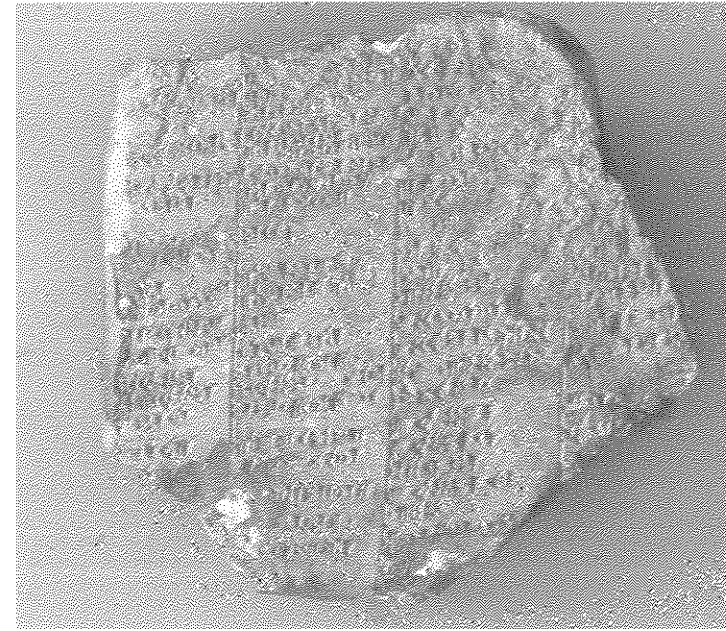


Fig. 1 Vocabulary from Ortakoy-Şapinuwa Cuneiform Archive.

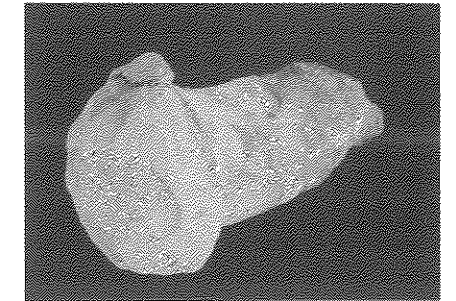


Fig. 2 Bullae with seal impressions belonging to officials.

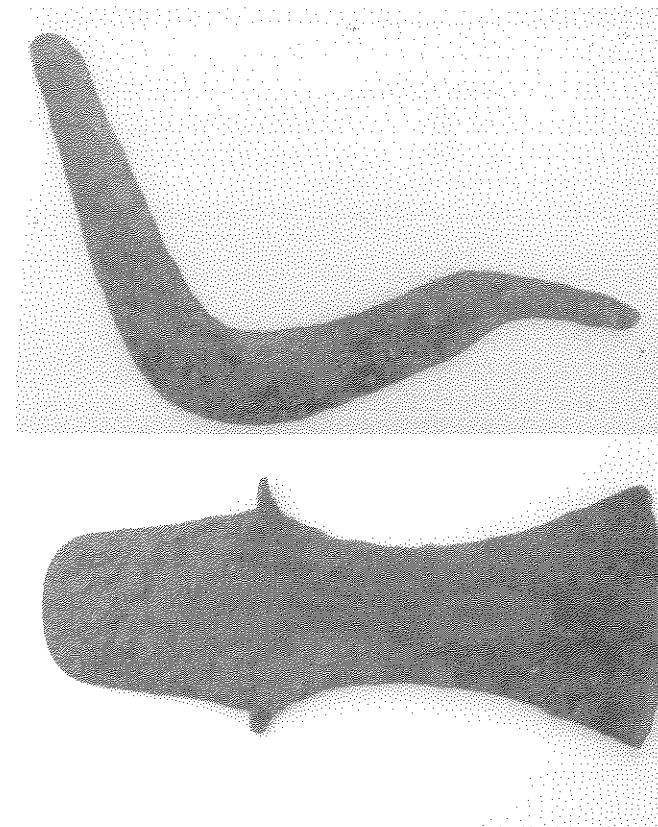


Fig. 4 Bronze axe with the cuneiform writing LUGAL.GAL (Building 'D'); Bronze spear head with the cuneiform writing LUGAL.GAL (Building 'C').

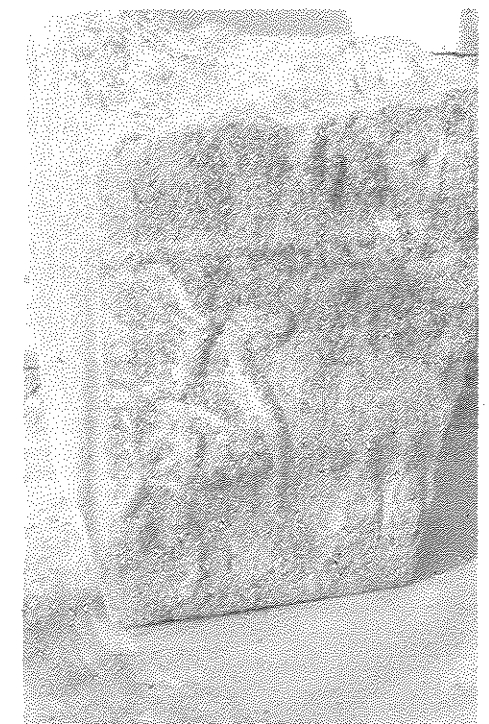


Fig. 3 Basalt Stone with hieroglyphic writing.

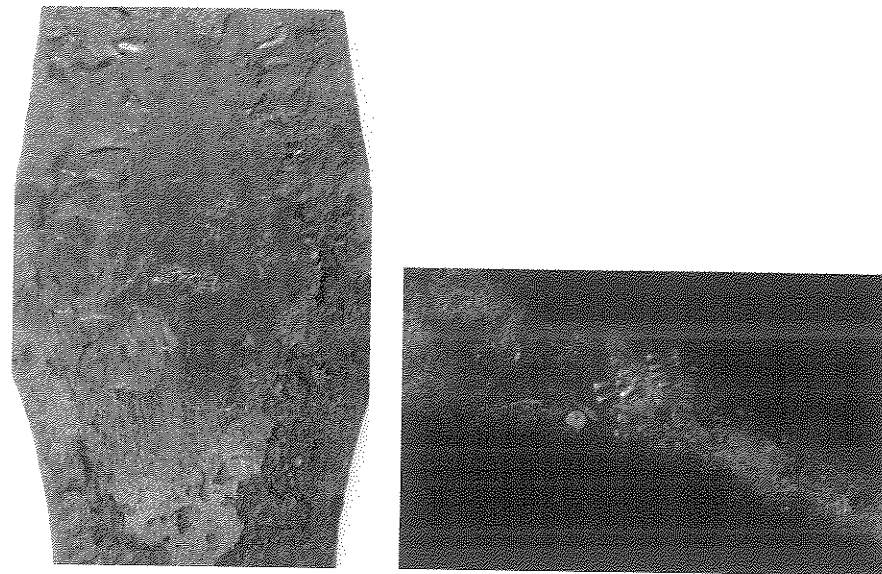


Fig. 5 Details of the cuneiform writing LUGAL.GAL on the bronze axe and bronze spear head.

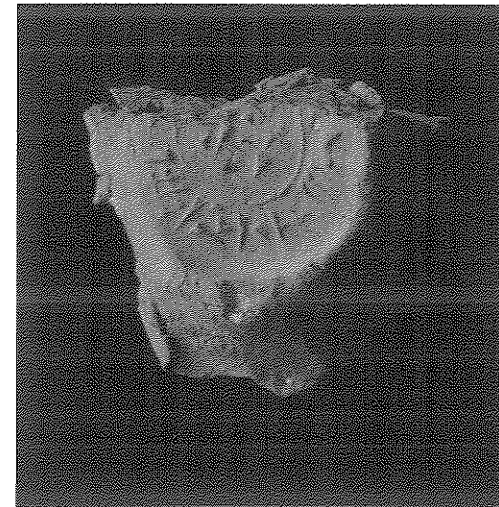


Fig. 7 Tabarna seal impression.

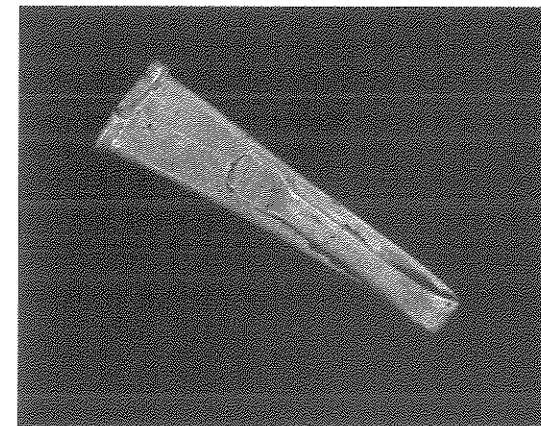


Fig. 10 Golden Pen/Stylus.

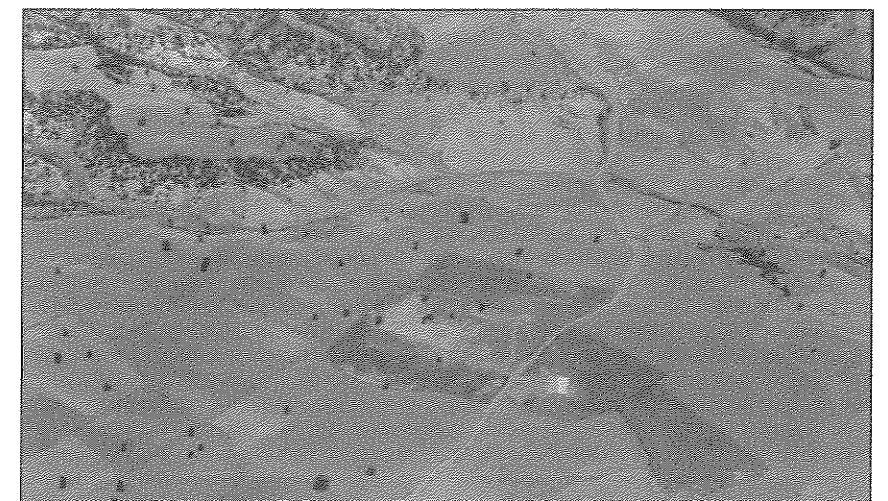






Fig. 12 The orthostate at the entrance of Building 'D' representing the Storm God with weapons.

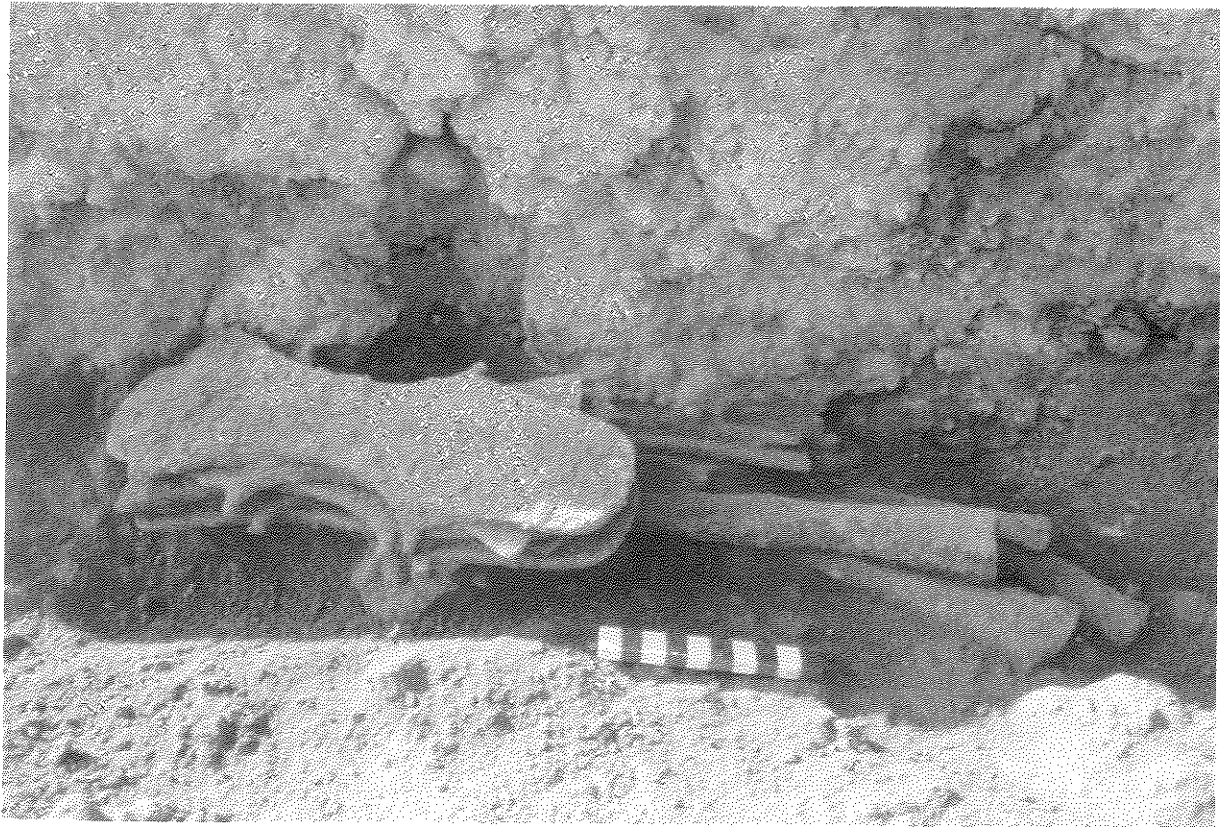


Fig. 14 View of the find spot with the bronze axes and bronze spear heads.

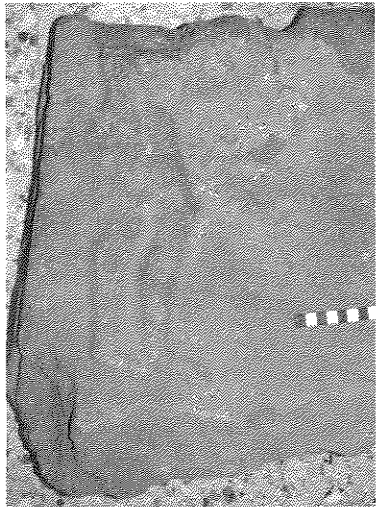


Fig. 13 Fragment of orthostate (entrance of Building 'D').

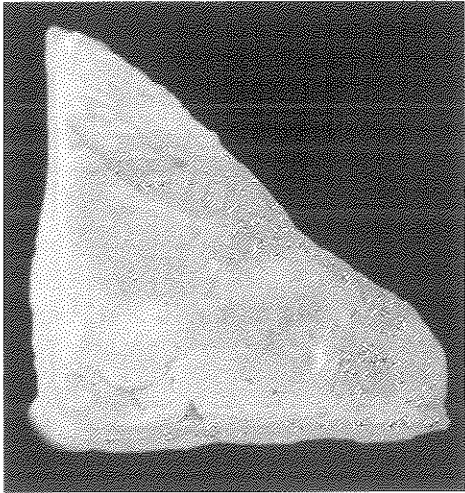


Fig. 15 The Tabarna seal impressions, sealed to the junction points of walls.
